Dear Parents/Carers,

Please note:

St Oswald's is a Nut-Free School. Children who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially lifethreatening allergic reaction. If someone has a nut allergy, it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts e.g., Nutella, can trigger an anaphylactic shock which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties. As a school we have a responsibility to keep all pupils, staff and visitors safe reducing any risk of harm so pupils, staff and visitors must not bring products containing nuts into school either in lunch boxes or as snacks. **To be clear, the following items must not be brought into school including Early Birds Breakfast Club:**

- Packets of nuts
- Peanut butter/Nutella sandwiches
- Cereals / Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Cakes made with nuts

This list is not exhaustive, so please check the packaging of products closely. No items containing nuts are prepared in the school kitchen.

Reminders:

- **School Lunches**: A week's notice **must** be given if you wish your child to change from packed lunches to school meals, or vice-versa. This is school policy thank you for your co-operation.
- **Letters:** Check your child's bag on a regular basis to make sure you are not missing out on anything! Any letters issued are also put on the school website. The older your child, the more responsibility they should take for making sure they remember to take letters home!
- **Absence (Illness):** If your child is absent for any reason during the term, please telephone the school **before** 9.30 am on the first morning of your child's absence. If we do not receive a message from, you will receive a telephone call from school to ascertain the reason for your child's absence. This is a "1st Day Contact" system

- and is part of our safeguarding procedure. On your child's return to school, please provide an email or letter explaining the absence.
- Absence (Medical/Dental Appointments, etc.) with Appointment Card: We ask that you make appointments out of school time. However, should you need to take your child out of school for an appointment, please provide school with a copy of the appointment card or letter at least two days in advance of the appointment. If an appointment card is not available, please write a note or email the school with the details of the appointment. Pupils should be collected from the Reception area near the school office. Please ensure that your child has been 'signed out." On your child's return to school, please sign your child back in. This is for health and safety and fire regulation purposes to ensure that all pupils are accounted for.

Friday 8th December:

The whole school will be involved in a Dance festival today which South Ribble Sports Partnership are running. PE kits must be in school.

Monday 11th December:

PTFA Sponsored Santa Dash today; all the children and staff will be joining in. The children can bring a Christmas hat, Santa beard or the full Santa outfit to wear for the event if they wish to. Sponsor money can be sent in in an envelope after the event. Last year we raised an amazing £975!

Tuesday 12th December:

Infant Nativity 'It's a Baby!' starring Reception, Y1 and Y2 in church. Performances at **2pm** and **6.30pm**. No need for tickets, just come along and enjoy the Nativity story! All costumes will be provided for the children. The performance will start **promptly** and last approx. 40 mins. Please note no food or drink can be brought in to the church. The evening performance starts at 6.30pm prompt in church. Children need to be dropped off in the school hall at 6.10pm.
