COVID Reference Guide for Parents:

The government has confirmed Tier 3 restrictions will come into force in Lancashire from midnight tonight. Please find attached latest COVID-19 information in the school setting and the new COVID-19 restriction poster for Tier 3.

Admin Reminders:

- Parent Pay Accounts It is essential that your child's Parent Pay account is in credit for school meals and Early Bird's. Please may I remind you to check your child's Parent Pay account on a regular basis and top-up as necessary. The account MUST stay in credit at all times. Thank you for your co-operation.
- Absence (Medical/Dental Appointments, etc.) with Appointment Card -Where possible, please try to make appointments out of school time. However, should you need to take your child out of school for an appointment, please provide school with a copy of the appointment card or letter <u>at least two days</u> in advance of the appointment. If an appointment card is not available, please write a note or email the school with the details of the appointment. Pupils should be collected from the Reception area near the school office.
