### **COVID Reference Guide for Parents:**

Please find attached latest COVID-19 information in the school setting. We are still waiting for official guidance from Public Health England regarding the latest change to the self-isolation period from 14 days to 10 days and therefore must continue with 14 days until we receive further clarification.

Parents need to be aware that we have been requested by Public Health and the DfE to follow arrangements for reporting positive cases as follows:

- Where a pupil tests positive for coronavirus, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should NOT be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- For the first 6 days after Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus, having developed symptoms within 48 hours of last being in school, you must contact the school via email no later than 10am.

## Nativity 2020:

Instead of our usual productions at Christmas, we spent all day Thursday filming a special Nativity for you to watch. Every class performed two songs and the whole performance tells the wonderful story of the First Christmas. The children worked so hard to learn the songs and produce their own artwork.
